INTRODUCTION

Emet Academy of learning serves the whole Kingdom of God, by providing teaching for those seeking an in-depth understanding of the Word of God, His power, authority, presence, anointing and the practical application thereof. We seek to advance a belief system that is spiritually vibrant, and sensitive to the demands imposed by both the past and the future. At the same time, we are committed to serving our students with love and excellence through truth, our motto.

Emet is the Hebrew word for truth and trustworthiness. This is the foundation of Emet Academy of Learning, as we are an institution grounded in “Sola Scriptura”, meaning that we recognize the Word of God, the Bible as we know it, as the final authority in our lives – from Genesis to Revelation. Emet is a dream that was born from a love of teaching the Word of God and a passion for mentoring students in the practical application of the Word in their daily lives. Those who desire to enhance their knowledge of the Word to make a difference in society.

1 Corinthians 7:20 – 24 says, “Each one should remain in the condition in which he was called. Were you a bondservant when called? Do not be concerned about it. (But if you gain your freedom, avail yourself of the opportunity.) For he who was called in the Lord as a bondservant is a freedman of the Lord. Likewise, he who was free when called is a bondservant of Christ. You were bought with a price; do not become bondservants of men. So, brothers, in whatever condition each was called, there let him remain with God.”

The time has come to answer the call to study the Word of God. Holy Spirit alone will call you, set you apart and prepare you for service and walking in Godly purpose. Thus, first the “calling” then the separation, then the preparation and then the sending: all in His time! During this time of separation, He equips the student as the Word says in **2 Corinthians 3:5** “not that we are competent of ourselves to think anything as of ourselves, but our competency is of God”.

VISSION, MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

Our aim at EMET is to develop and impart knowledge of the Word of Abba Father, enabling a believer to communicate and defend it, and to prepare his/her heart for the continual study of it and application in all areas of their day to day lives. We intend to provide men and woman with the skills to be effective witnesses, leaders, and stewards of the Good News of Christ to all believers around the world – and to reach out to the lost souls we meet daily.

VISION

To make disciples who have a solid foundation in the Word of Abba Father. To promote an intimate relationship with the only living God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of Israel, to promote an understanding of holiness and obedience in their covenant relationship with Him and to raise Godly leaders who can stand their ground in a chaotic world.

MISSION

Our mission is to train students to serve the Lord in all areas of their lives and recognize the calling and purpose that Abba Father has for each one of us. Your calling is unique and designed to bring glory to Him and liberty to us.

OBJECTIVES

- To promote personal, spiritual growth and become an effective ambassador of the Kingdom of God
- Consistently observe the truths of the word of God and experience His promised over His covenant bride.
- To gain an understanding/knowledge of the Word of God to equip you for daily life.

GLOBAL AVAILABILITY

The fact that this program is specially designed for distance learning, allows students, through EMET's Virtual Classroom design, to be equipped and trained, at leisure, nationally and internationally. This enables the learners to remain in their daily work while being equipped part-time.

ACCREDITATION

EMET is an in-house biblical theology course. By choice, EMET has decided to move away from accreditation at governing accreditation bodies. As mentioned in the introduction, EMET is grounded in "Sola Scriptura" meaning we only recognise the Word of God as complete and final authority. We do not endorse or promote any other source, whether teaching or person, as explanation to the Word of God. Our motto at EMET is: Let the Word of God explain the Word of God. We are not prepared to debate the existence of God or the relevance of His Word. If you want to gain a deeper in depth understanding of the Word of Abba Father, EMET is the program for you.

No credit transfer can be accepted or transferred to or from any other theology institute. The certificate of completion is not credit bearing and not a secular theology qualification.

LEARNING MODELS

FORMAL STUDIES

This refers to a structured learning model. Teachings are released once a week and learning is aided by class tests, assignments, online Q & A sessions, and a year-end exam. This enables you to really press in deeper and understand all concepts with ease. You will learn in your first module of year one that studying the Word of God is the highest form of worship, and during that time Abba Father really writes the revelations from His Word on

the tablets of your heart for you to use what you have learnt when ministering unto the bride. An EMET certificate will be issued for each year of successful study. There is a pass requirement to move on to the next year of study. Each year has its own teaching videos and the student will only have access to the videos for that specific year.

ATTENDANCE STUDIES

This refers to a self-study model. Teachings are released once a week and students work through the lessons at their own pace and time during a one-year period. Students will only have access to the videos for one year. An Emet certificate of attendance will be issued for each year of completion. Only year one and year two of the program can be completed through attendance studies. Formal studies are required for a student to move on to third or fourth year.

HOW DOES IT ALL WORK?

As soon as a course commences you will receive your year planner as well as login details for the virtual classroom. You will then be able to login when and where you want to watch your teaching videos, complete tests, or upload assignments. There is an app available for any smart phone so that you can have access to your teachings any time and any place. Please note you will only have access to your current year of study. If you are enrolled as a second-year student, you will only be able to view second year videos. The videos will only be available for that year and not thereafter. Make sure that you make proper notes for yourself and keep your study material in a good condition so that you can refer to those notes in the future.

Emet learning material is protected by copyright, and permission must be obtained from the writer prior to any prohibited reproduction, storage in a retrieval system, or transmission in any form or by any means, electronic, mechanical, photocopying, recording, or likewise.

If you are an EMET student who wants to work through a certain year again you are welcome to request that your videos for that year be opened at a fee of R 1 500.00 per year. Those videos will then be available for a period of 12 months.

REGISTRATION

Our biblical theology courses have two intakes every year. One in January and one in July. The end times short course does not have a specific intake date and students can register at any time.

Any account that is in arrears will have access to the virtual classroom suspended until the arrears is settled. Any student with outstanding fees will not be allowed to participate in any further assessment activities until such time that the account is settled. No student may register for a new academic year if there are still fees outstanding from the previous year.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

We believe that each student will be completely satisfied with their studies. If it is necessary for a student to discontinue studies, the following will apply:

- Registration fees are not refundable
- Cancellation must be done on email within 60 days of the start of the course.
- A valid reason must be given for the discontinuation. (Laziness and offence taken is not a valid reason.)
- Cancelling after the 60-day period means that the student will be liable for 100% of the full tuition fee.
- No refunds will be given on any short course offered by EMET
- Refunding of fees will only be considered by the academic dean, for cases where cancellation happened within the 60-day period and fees that were paid in advance.
- Should any learner encounter financial difficulties during their year of study, it is the full responsibility of the learner to contact the EMET offices and arrange for payment. Queries should be directed to finance@emetgroup.co.za.

- It is not in any way the responsibility of the EMET office staff to pursue a student that we receive no feedback from. If EMET does not receive anything in writing from the student, we as EMET will assume that you are still enrolled and viewing classes.
- Each student will be responsible for their own cancellation. No cancellation will be accepted on behalf of another learner.

A credit balance on a student's account shall be paid out upon receipt of a written request from the student. Payments are made at the end of each month. Credit notices received later than the 15th of each month will only be paid out the following month.

ASSESSMENTS

CLASS TESTS

Class tests are completed on the online system and consist of multiple choice as well as true/false questions. You will be asked to answer approximately 40 questions. The system will allow each candidate sufficient time for the test. Your facilitator will explain the whole process before you complete the test. Once completed your mark will be available immediately. Class test dates will be indicated on your year planner. There will be a timeframe of 3 days in which you can complete your test at any time that suits you. Class tests will account for 15% of the year mark for year 1 – 3. Should you not be able to complete your test within the given 3-day period you need to contact the office in advance to make other arrangements. Failing to complete your class test without a valid reason will result in achieving 0%. A student will have to achieve 50% to pass a class test. Class tests are not open for re-writes as they form part of a year mark.

ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments are available as pdf documents on the online system at a given time during the year. All dates are available on the yearly planner. You will have 3 weeks to complete an assignment. You will submit your completed assignment on your online profile where it will be graded using annotate pdf. Once grading is complete you will receive a notification to view your marks and the annotate pdf. Failure to submit an assignment will result in achieving 0%. A student will have to achieve 50% to pass an assignment. Assignments are not open for re-writes as they form part of a year mark.

4-1 YEAR END TEST

This test will form part of the year mark for the fourth year. It will be completed as a written test as per EMET exam regulations. This test forms part of your year mark and must be completed in order to carry on with the fourth-year program. It will account for 25% of your overall mark. A student will have to achieve a minimum of 45% to pass this test. Dates are set out at the beginning of each year and should be adhered to. This test will be written on a Saturday morning at Christian Faith Worship Centre should you be within a 60km radius from Krugersdorp. Arrangements will be made for students to write in their own area or country, and we will guide you through the process when the time comes.

EXAMS

Exam dates are fixed and given on the year planner upon course commencement. Exams are written on a Saturday morning at Christian Faith Worship Centre in Krugersdorp. Should you not live within a 60km radius, arrangements can be made to write in your area. The EMET team will guide you through the process. Only in case of medical emergencies and death in the family will a student be allowed to write a supplementary exam. A student will have to achieve at least 45% to pass the examination.

WEIGHTING AND PROMOTIONAL MARKS

YEAR 1 TO 3 YEAR MARK

Class tests: 15%

Assignments: 35%

A year mark of at least 50% will be necessary to qualify for examination.

YEAR 1 TO 3 PROMOTIONAL MARK

The year mark and examination will count 50% each. An overall mark of 50% is needed to be promoted to the next year of study.

YEAR 4 YEAR MARK

Assignments: 25%

Year 1 end of year test: 25%

A year mark of at least 50% will be necessary to qualify for examination.

YEAR 4 PROMOTIONAL MARK

The year mark and examination will count 50% each. An overall mark of 50% is needed to be successfully pass year 4.

RE-EXAMINATION

Should a student not pass his/her exam, they will have the option to re-write on the given date. No other dates can be negotiated. A re-write fee of R500 will be payable to book your seat for the re-examination.

ORDINATION

Completing the EMET program does not automatically guarantee ordination. Ordination is a separate process altogether. For more info regarding ordination contact our offices.

LEARNER BEHAVIOUR, CONDUCT AND VALUES
